When is a clause unfair?

When there is an **imbalance** between the rights of consumers and traders, which **significantly** disadvantages consumers.



You have the right to fair contract terms. If your contract contains unfair terms, you are not bound by them. If the contract cannot be performed without such unfair terms, then the entire contract is non-binding.
